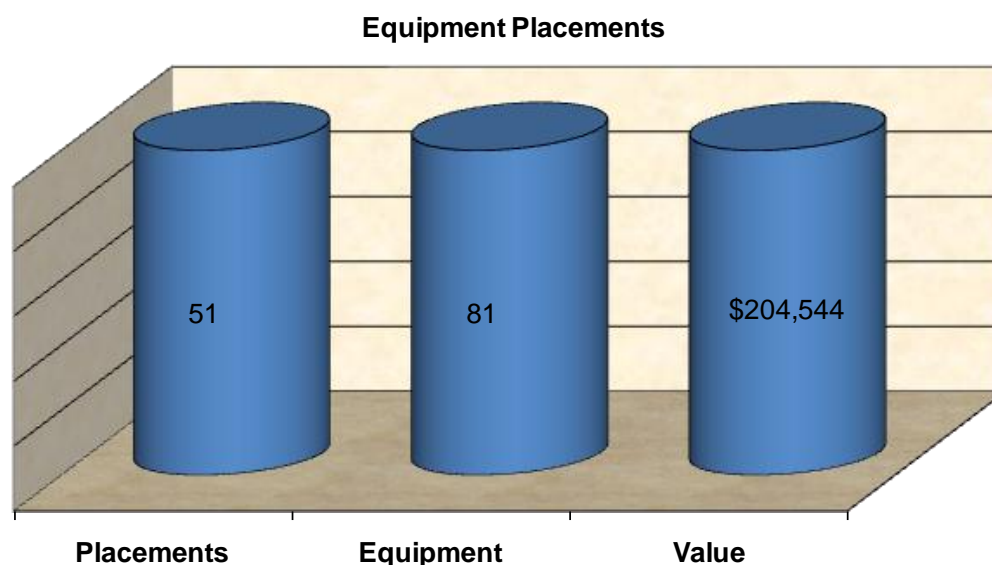


KIDS MOBILITY NETWORK ANNOUNCES FIRST YEAR RESULTS

In its first year of operations, Kids Mobility Network provided over \$200,000 of community benefit. The organization accomplished the following operating metrics in its first year of operations as illustrated below:

- **51 Placements** – Defined as a “fitting” whereby a client receives equipment.
- **81 Pieces of Durable Medical Equipment** (“DME”)
- **\$204,544 of Community Benefit**

Once we’ve secured funding for staffing and necessary operating expenses, we expect our results to increase immensely.”
