“The goal of the organization is to utilize this equipment to provide greater safety, independence, and mobility for children in their development years,” added Christy Kopp. “As the mother of a disabled child, I understand that it is so important for children to have the necessary equipment that allows them to optimize interaction with their peers. It helps them to develop important relationships, social skills and self-confidence.”
