## **KIDS MOBILITY NETWORK REPLACES CHILD'S STOLEN WHEELCHAIR**

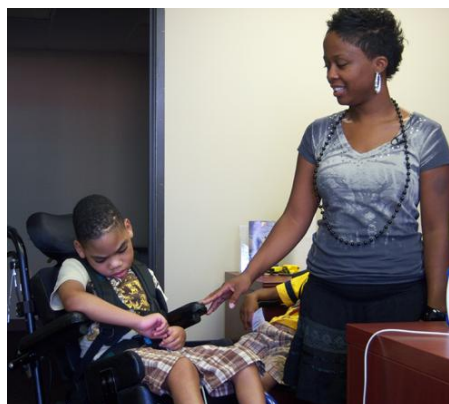
*Denver, Colorado, July 21, 2010* - Kids Mobility Network, Inc. provided a wheelchair to a seven-year-old boy whose wheelchair had been stolen from the family's garage. On Wednesday, July 21, 2010, Kids Mobility Network learned of a family that became the victims of thieves that had stolen a wheelchair and sprung into action to replace the boy's wheelchair.

Denver's Fox 31 News aired the story of the Brice family on Tuesday night and repeated it on Wednesday morning news programs. "We knew that Kids Mobility Network was the solution to this family's problems," stated Peter Kopp, President of Kids Mobility Network. "I contacted the newsroom at Fox 31 to let them know that we could step in to help this family immediately."

Later the same day, D'Marus Brice and his mother Tesa Brice were in the Kids Mobility Network offices being fit for a wheelchair. D'Marus received a gently used tilt-in-space pediatric manual wheelchair fitted specifically for his needs worth more than \$7,000.

"Organizations like these are godsend. I am very excited for D'Marus and he loves it." said Tesa Brice, mother of D'Marus Brice.

"I am very pleased that we could step up to help this great family," said Peter Kopp. "It is very fulfilling to be able to provide this family with the equipment they need to return their lives to their typical baseline. That's what Kids Mobility Network is here to do!"
